He is also the winner of several competitions, including the Strauss Competition in Munich, Germany, the Korea Music Competition in Korea and the Tokyo Music Competiton in Japan. and he also received a Song Prize in Debut Competition in Würzburg, Germany.

Jeongmeen studied singing at the Seoul National University (SNU) in South Korea under the direction of Philip Kang and Attila Jun, Kammersänger at the Opera Stuttgart. He is currently pursuing his Masters degree at the Theaterakademie August Everding in Munich, studying with Frieder Lang.
